Method

While many of you have likely heard of the SOAP method of study, we at DTM like to suggest a slightly different approach to Bible study. This study journal is designed to help you dig deeper into the word and help you apply it every day.

SOIAPS

Scripture, Observation, Interpretation, Application, Prayer, Share

Day 1

Read: Matthew 7:11

SOIAPS: Matthew 7:11

Scripture

S Stands for scripture. You'll write out the scripture for the day here.

Ask God to reveal new things about the verse to you as you write. You'll be amazed at what stands out to you! Remember this is a Living Word each time you read or write a verse something new can be revealed to you.

Observation

Write down your
observations on the
passage

O Stands for observation. What stands out to you in the verse today? Who was it written by? Who was it written to? What haven't you noticed before today? What comes before and after the verse? Why do you feel that's important?

Interpretation

Rewrite the scripture in your own words using the context of the surrounding verses

I Stands for Interpretation. It's important that we realize all scripture is given to us within a framework called 'context'. Here you'll look at the surrounding verses and rewrite the verse in your own words. This allows us to view the verse for what it is saying.

Application

Write down how you feel this verse applies to you today

A Stands for application. In this step you'll write out how you feel the verse applies to your life today and from here forward. Ask yourself, In light of this verse what should I change in my life? How will I make that change? This is not meant as a condemning step, but rather an encouraging one.

Prayer

Write down your prayer for today

P Stands for prayer. Pray and ask God to help make the verse and all you've written stick in your mind and your heart. Ask Him to help you make any changes, and praise Him for all that He has done and will do for you!

Share

Write down how you plan to share your study with someone today

S here stands for share. It's so important to not only learn and study the word for ourselves, but we should share it with others! Ask God to show you how to share this verse, or a truth you learned today with someone. Write down a short 2 or 3 sentence way you can convey this truth and speak life into a person today.

Introduction

He is Worthy of Prayer, Worship, & Praise

When God first created man in His image, it was His desire that Adam and Eve would enjoy the fruits of creation and their place in it. We all know Adam and Eve sinned by eating the fruit of the tree, but God is a good father. His desire for fellowship with His creation meant that before the foundations of the world a plan was already in place for redemption.
